The spirit of this Rolfing Movement Training will be one of living embodied questions that encourage curiosity about movement in daily life and how this might broaden the practical potential of our work as Rolfers. Ample time will be given for embodied exploration and processing; as well as hands on work with others and theory.

The course will be divided in two parts. The first will be in a lovely place in Italy (to be announced); the second in Munich at the European Rolfing Association.

Part one will be devoted to: embodied exploration of our own gravity project; tonic function theory; becoming empowered to work in a person-centered way.

Part two is about giving Rolfing Movement Sessions, with supportive supervision and feedback, while deepening the enquiry started in part one of this training. With this in mind you will learn how to orchestrate a sequence of 3 Rolfing Movement sessions and also how to efficiently bring functional work into your Rolfing ten series.

Through the training you should have acquired these skills and tools:

- a clear and practical understanding of Tonic Function
- a deeper presence and a more versatile capacity to hold a therapeutic relationship
- a more developed ability to see and understand the body in motion
- a wider spectrum of touch
- a broader capacity to use language as an intervention
- how to work with Rolfing Movement in groups
- a more creative commitment toward self exploration

**Pierpaola Volpones** certified as Rolf Movement Practitioner in 1986 and Rolfer in 1988. She has been an Advanced Rolfer since 1996.

Her approach is the result of the meeting of the original Rolfing Movement work and the Hubert Godard view.

Pierpaola is a Rolfing and Rolf Movement instructor; she teaches Basic Rolfing Trainings, block and modular formats.



**Giovanni Felicioni** certified as a Rolfer in 1999 and has been an Advanced Rolfer since 2005. He is a Rolf Movement practitioner since 2000 and has studied Tonic Function work on a regular basis with Hubert Godard since 1999.

Before that Giovanni certified as a Yoga Teacher with Mary Stewart (in the lineage of Vanda Scaravelli) in 1991 and now trains Yoga Teachers in London.

Giovanni runs a Rolfing practice in London teaches regularly for the Rolf Institute and runs movement and meditation workshops and retreats internationally.
